



Business of Science Leadership Award 2019

Award Criteria:

First awarded in 2017, the Business of Science Leadership Award is a national award, paying tribute to an individual who has demonstrated outstanding business leadership in an area of science and innovation.

The judges also intend to again make a “Special Recognition” award to an individual who has demonstrated excellence to the business of science within the geographical proximity of this year’s conference.

Application Process

To apply for the Business of Science Leadership Award you must first ensure you meet the above criteria and that you can demonstrate this through answering the questions provided below.

Once the entry form has been completed this should be submitted for consideration via email at BOSLAward@road3.co.uk no later than **5pm on Friday 1st March 2019**. Please also submit any additional or supporting documents, such as videos or press releases, where relevant to your application.

From there, the expert panel of judges, identified below, will be responsible for assessing each submission on its merits against the stated award criteria.

Applicants will be shortlisted based upon the following business/organisation categories:

- Large Business
- SME Business
- Public/Charity

Applicants will be shortlisted before arriving at the identification of the winner, with the award being presented at this year’s Business of Science Pre-Conference Dinner taking place on Wednesday, 15th May 2019 at the Double Tree Hilton Hotel, Granary Wharf, Leeds.
